## CHECKLIST FOR OBTAINING LIQUID WASTE HAULER HEALTH PERMIT

- 1. Register truck(s) with the Department of Motor Vehicles.
- 2. Insure vehicle(s), and furnish the County of Santa Cruz with adequate certificates of liability insurance. Additionally insured wording is as follows:

County of Santa Cruz, its officers, agents and employees,

- 3. Review the <u>Procedures for Liquid Waste Pumpers</u> for the County of Santa Cruz. All companies must comply with all requirements set forth in Chapter 7.42 of the County Code.
- 4. Obtain a valid certificate from the County Sealer of Weights and Measures for the volume of the tank(s) and submit a copy with the registration form.
- 5. Set up an account at an approved disposal site. Contact information is provided below.
- 6. All grease hauler trucks must possess a valid Inedible Kitchen Grease certificate issued by the Department of Food and Agriculture. For the most current information concerning registrations, please contact the State Department of Food and Agriculture at (916) 900-5004.
- 7. Register for a permit with Environmental Health:
  - a. Complete the registration form
  - b. Submit registration form with required fees and documentation
  - c. Contact EH to arrange an appointment for an inspection
- 8. Pass the truck inspection and receive a decal.
- 9. Health permits are provided after all listed trucks are inspected and approved.
